DURING YOUR VISIT:

Outside the building:

- Does this building look like the other buildings near it? How is it different?
- Finish this sentence, the Guggenheim Museum looks like a _____.

Inside the building:

- Pick up a free, fun family activity guide about the building's design. (Ask for it at the Admissions or Information Desks.)
- Go to the top and follow the curved floor all the way down. This shape is called a spiral.

Before and After Your Visit:

- Act it out! With your child, spin around and make spirals with your body. Can you move your body up and down like the ramp in the museum?
- Together, make a spiral mobile: decorate a paper plate with crayons. Use scissors to cut it into a spiral. Start on the outside edge and keep cutting along the circle. Did you know that young children need lots of practice to learn how to use scissors? Encouraging them to hold the scissors with their thumb in the top loop can help. Attach a string to the tip of the spiral and hang up your new mobile.
